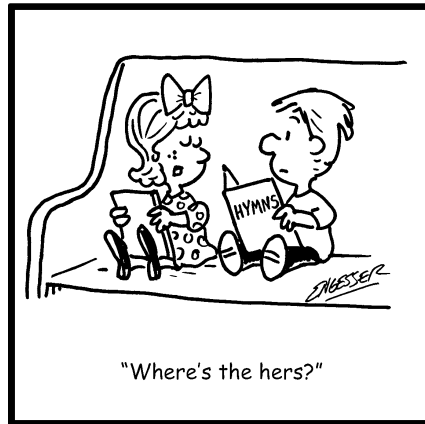

STUDY QUESTIONS



What character traits of your Mom stand out in your mind?

The writer of Proverbs 31:10-31 writes the proverb as an acrostic poem (in Hebrew). It is probably independent of the 31:1-9, a writing of King Lemuel. Why are acrostic poems used in Biblical literature (like Psalm 119)?

What the woman of Proverbs 31 accomplishes is remarkable in light of traditional restrictions placed on women in the ancient world. What gives her the opportunity to accomplish what she does?

According to verses 20-22, the virtuous woman is not afraid to give to the poor, because she has already taken care of her own household. What does this teach me?

Verse 30 – How do you see the contrast between charm & beauty versus “The fear of the lord?” (see I Peter 3:3-4)

Verse 31 – Her works “praise her in the gates” and also bring praise to God – (“Let your light so shine before men, so that they may see you good works and glorify your father in heaven!”) (Matthew 5:16) How can my good works bring glory to God?
